In political science, peer-reviewed journal articles in international journals are the central hallmark of excellent research. The rejection rate of political science journals is very high. On average, 80% of all journal submissions to good journals are rejected. When assessing journals, the Social Science Citation Index by Thompson Reuter is used as a guide. As a rule of thumb, journals with a 5-year impact factor of >1.5 are considered excellent. The journal ratings from Google Scholar are also used as a guide.
